

Psalm 95:1-11

Text: The prophetic psalm called to Israelite worshipers to invite them to hear God's voice and warn them not to harden their hearts.

- The psalmist invited the Israelite worshiper to hear God's voice by responding with two acceptable postures for worshiping God (1-7).
- The psalmist invited the Israelite worshiper to hear God's voice by receiving the warning of an unacceptable posture for worshiping God (8-11).

Theology: Believe the gospel of Jesus today to worship God with proper posture.

- Belief in the gospel postures the heart to sing to Jesus (cf. Eph. 5:18-20).
- Belief in the gospel postures the heart to bow before Jesus (cf. Phil. 2:9-11).
- Unbelief hardens the heart for wrath from God (cf. Heb. 3:7-19).

Today: Mature in Faith to Mature As a Worshiper.

- What do you believe about Jesus?
- What excuses or timidity needs rebuked in your life as a worshiper?
- What corrections can you make as a worshiper of Jesus?
- Are you maturing as a worshiper of Jesus or hardening because of unbelief?
